Tracy Klein MS WHCNP FNP

Tracy Klein has been the Advanced Practice Consultant for the Oregon State Board of Nursing since 1998. She is an adjunct faculty member of the graduate School of Nursing at

Oregon Health Sciences University, and a clinical instructor in Pediatrics for their School of Medicine. Ms. Klein is dual certified in women's health and family practice. Klein has served on the Advanced Practice Task Force for the National Council of State Boards of Nursing from 1999-2001, and was the Public Policy chair for the American College of Nurse Practitioners in 2004. Ms. Klein's clinical practice has included public health, care of women and adolescents, pediatrics, and private practice in inpatient/outpatient management of eating disorders. She currently serves on appointment to numerous rule and policy making commissions, including the Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force Sane Certification Commission and the Oregon Human Resource Commission's Practitioner-Managed Prescription Drug Plan.

Renee McLeod DNSc APRN CPNP



Dr. Renee McLeod is a Professor and Director of Graduate Education and Advanced Practice Programs at Arizona State University College of Nursing. She is a member of the Pediatric Clinical Teaching Faculty at Scripps Mercy Hospital and Clinic in San Diego where she maintains a clinical and research practice. Dr. McLeod has been a pediatric nurse practitioner for 30 years. She received her B.S. in Nursing from the University of Tennessee, Memphis; her M.S. in Nursing from the University of California, San Francisco; and her Doctorate in Nursing Science from Widener University in Pennsylvania. Dr. McLeod is a past president of the National Association of Pediatric Nurse Practitioners. Her research interests are in the use of handheld technology to create evidenced based practice, and patient compliance. She has studied medication compliance issues in children of Mexican-Americans who have Tuberculosis and Atopic Dermatitis.
