**FINDINGS OF FACT,  
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW  
AND ORDER NO. 1211042**

10 On November 20, 2015, the Arizona State Board of Nursing (“Board”) considered the State’s  
11 Motion to Deem Allegations Admitted and Recommended Discipline and Respondent’s Response to  
12 the Motion, if any, at the Arizona Board of Nursing, 4747 North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 200, Phoenix Arizona  
13 85014-3655. Elizabeth A. Campbell, Assistant Attorney General, appeared on behalf of the State.  
14 Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel.

15 On November 20, 2015, the Board granted the State’s Motion to Deem Allegations Admitted.  
16 Based upon A.R.S. § 32-1663(F) and Notice of Charges No. 1211042 issued in this matter, the Board  
17 adopts the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and **REVOKES** Respondent’s license.

19 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

20 1. Kerry Lynn Farley (“Respondent”) holds Board issued registered (“RN”) nurse license  
21 no. RN154627.  
22

23 2. On or about November 2, 2012, the Board received a complaint alleging that on  
24 November 2, 2012, Respondent performed beyond her scope of practice as a registered nurse when  
25 she gave an intravenous bolus of Propofol, without a doctor’s order while employed at Scottsdale  
26 Healthcare Thompson Peak, in Scottsdale, Arizona through Integrated Staffing Registry. As a result  
27 of the complaint, the Board conducted an investigation.

1 this chapter (effective August 2, 2012); and A.A.C. R4-19-403 9. Failing to take appropriate action to  
2 safeguard a patient's welfare or follow policies and procedures of the nurse's employer designed to  
3 safeguard the patient; 12. Assuming patient care responsibilities that the nurse lacks the education to  
4 perform, for which the nurse has failed to maintain nursing competence, or that are outside the scope of  
5 practice of the nurse; 25. Failing to: a. Furnish in writing a full and complete explanation of a matter  
6 reported pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1664; and 31. Practicing in any other manner that gives the Board  
7 reasonable cause to believe the health of a patient or the public may be harmed (effective January 31,  
8 2009).

### 11 ORDER

12 In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Board issues the following  
13 Order:

14 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1664(N), the Board **REVOKES** registered nurse license number  
15 RN154627 issued to Kerry Lynn Farley.

### 17 RIGHT TO PETITION FOR REHEARING OR REVIEW

18 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09, Respondent may file, in writing, a motion for rehearing  
19 or review within thirty (30) days after service of this decision with the Arizona State Board of  
20 Nursing. The motion for rehearing or review shall be made to the attention of Hearing  
21 Department, Arizona State Board of Nursing, 4747 North 7th Street Ste 200, Phoenix AZ 85014-  
22 3655, and must set forth legally sufficient reasons for granting a rehearing. A.A.C. R4-19-608.

26 or review within thirty (30) days after service of this decision, Respondent shall be prohibited
