2. Develop recommendations for Advisory Opinions related to Advanced Practice scope of practice issues;
3. Collaborate with the Scope of Practice Committee regarding mutual practice issues;
4. Collaborate with the Education Committee regarding Advanced Practice educational programs;
5. Facilitate communication between the Advanced Practice Nursing community and the Board.

The committee meets approximately four per times a year in the Board Room at 4747 North 7th Street, Suite 200, in Phoenix.
