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# Definition of Terms

- **Total Enrollment:** All students enrolled pre-licensure nursing program
- **Total Admissions:** Students admitted first semester nursing program
- **Advanced Placement Admissions:** Students/LPN's admitted to later semesters of an RN program
- **Capacity:** Student placements available in nursing program

# Definition of Terms

- **Graduates from original cohort:** Students who graduated with their admission class
- **Repeated or dropped back:** Students took longer time to complete nursing program


# Assumptions

- **LPN data:** LPN traditional programs, not multiple exit programs
- **Students qualified & not admitted may be overestimated:**
  - Students may apply to multiple programs
  - Students may be qualified for one program, but not another

# Assumptions

- **Data is:**
  - calendar year
  - based on school self reports
  - for pre-licensure students/graduates unless specifically noted RN-BSN






## RN PROGRAM ENROLLMENT

# LPN program enrollment


- Enrollments in LPN programs doubled from 2001 to 2003—increased 140%





## TOTAL PROGRAM ADMISSIONS 2001-2003




- Admissions increased since 2002 by 35.79%

  - 2003 3.5%






# 2003 - ALL PROGRAMS CAPACITY – ADMITS – QUALIFIED/NOT ADMITTED


# LPN Admits/Capacity/Qualified







# Total Graduates for all Programs




# 2002/2003 RN GRADUATE CHARACTERISTICS




# RN NCLEX EXAM

- 7% Fewer takers in 2003
- 1% Fewer passers
- 40% Decrease in 1<sup>st</sup> time failures





# RN to BSN/MS Admissions




- Grand Canyon significantly increased enrollment
- U of P was first measured in 2003
- U of A is an RN to MS program
- ASU 2003 includes 9 RN to MS students

# RN to BSN/MS Grads



- Graduates fell slightly for most programs from 2002 to 2003

# Faculty



- Higher number of openings in BSN programs
- Numbers are in Full-time equivalents
- Associate Degree programs employ double the part-time faculty as full time

# Summary

- Nursing program enrollment, admissions and graduates are increasing
- BSN graduates comprise less than 30% of new graduates
- Expect to see graduates of RN programs increase in 2004 due to increases in admissions
