

Arizona State Board of Nursing Annual Program Reports

2001-2006

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Definition of Terms

- **Total Enrollment:** All students enrolled pre-licensure nursing program
- **Total Admissions:** Students admitted first semester nursing program
- **Students Offered Placement:** The number of students offered a placement in a 2006 admission cohort.
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Definitions

- **Students Registered for the First Clinical Course:** The number of students of those offered a placement that actually registered in 2006.
- **Students Registered Who Did Not Attend:** The number of students who registered for the first nursing clinical but never attended classes
- .
- **Open Placements in the First Nursing Clinical Course on the First Day of Class:** The number of placements that were not filled on the first day of classes.
- **Qualified Students Not Admitted to the Session for Which They Applied:** Number of students who were qualified for admission but were either denied, placed on a wait list, or admitted to a semester other than the one they applied for.

- **Advanced Placement Admissions:**

Students/LPN's admitted to later semesters of an RN program

- **Capacity:** Student placements available in a nursing program

Definition of Terms

- **Graduates from original cohort:** Students who graduated with their admission class
- **Repeated or dropped back:** Students took longer time to complete nursing program


Assumptions

- **LPN data:** LPN traditional programs, not multiple exit programs
- **Students qualified & not admitted may be overestimated:**
 - Students may apply to multiple programs
 - Students may be qualified for one program, but not another


Assumptions

- **Data is:**
 - Calendar year
 - Based on school self reports
 - For pre-licensure students/graduates unless specifically noted RN-BSN
 - Number of unfilled placements should not be interpreted to mean that these placements are available to other qualified students.
 - These data apply only to in-state programs approved by the Board.
 - The category of associate degree nursing programs also includes one diploma nursing program

What happens from admission? 2002-2006-RN




Cohorts--Percent who graduated on time/lagged/or dropped



What happens to PN students?


Percent of PN students who graduated on time/lagged/or dropped



- ENROLLEMENT INCREASES


- 2001-2002 6.2%

LPN program enrollment


- Enrollments in LPN programs doubled from 2001 to 2003—increased 140%



TOTAL PROGRAM ADMISSIONS 2001-2003










2006 - ALL PROGRAMS

CAPACITY – ADMITS – QUALIFIED/NOT ADMITTED




QUALIFIED BUT NOT ENROLLED 2006



LPN Qualified Not Admitted





Total Graduates for all Programs





2006 RN Program Graduates




2006 RN GRADUATE CHARACTERISTICS

2006 RN Graduate Characteristics






RN NCLEX EXAM





RN to BSN/MS Admissions




RN to BSN/MS Grads
