I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:53 p.m., Tuesday, March 26, 2013.

The following Board members were present: Quinn, McCormies, Berrigan, Dalton, Harrell, Johnson Snider, Gutierrez and Busby.

Quinn presided.

Quinn welcomed members of the audience, explained the procedure for addressing the Board, and stated the mission of the Board.

II. APRN/RN/LPN/CNA Investigative Report/Potential Summary Suspension Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B) and/or Acceptance of a Consent Agreement and/or Adoption of Complaint & Notice of Hearing

II.A. Justin Livingston Sirinek TRN176783 (Greabell)

The proceeding began at 2:54 p.m., with the following Board members present: Quinn, McCormies, Berrigan, Dalton, Harrell, Johnson, Snider, Gutierrez, and Busby.

Greabell addressed the Board and requested the Board summarily suspend TRN license and denial of permanent RN license.

Attorney Cary Lackey was present and addressed the Board. Sirinek was present, telephonically, and available for questions.

Based upon the information presented at this meeting, all Board members verbally agreed that a showing of extraordinary circumstances or the possibility of irreparable harm has been made supporting the need for a Summary Suspension.

Quinn moved, Berrigan seconded, and it was unanimously carried, based upon the information presented at this meeting and the information contained in the investigative report, to accept and adopt the proposed preliminary Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the Findings set forth in the draft Order attached to the investigative report.

All Board members verbally agreed that the foregoing conduct poses an immediate threat to the public health, safety, or welfare and requires emergency action pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

Quinn moved, Dalton seconded, based upon the information presented at this meeting, the findings of fact and statute/rule violations identified in the investigative report, and the updated investigative report, make a finding that public health safety and welfare imperatively requires emergency action to issue an Order summarily suspending the temporary license of Justin Sirinek pending further hearing, and to issue an Order of Denial of permanent RN license. The hearing shall be promptly instituted and determined within 60 days. The motion carried with eight in favor and one abstained.
